The Federal Poverty Level (FPL) Tables are used to determine income eligibility for the Breast and Cervical cancer screening and diagnostic services through the NWWP:

Who is Eligible?  
(Must meet all 3 requirements)

- ✓ Women between 21 and 64 years.
- ✓ AND Uninsured or underinsured (screening and diagnostic procedures) women enrolled in your Tribal Clinic.
- ✓ AND Women with low-incomes (at or below 250% Federal Poverty Level).

Underinsured:

You might be underinsured if your health plan does not cover cancer diagnostic procedures, or you can't afford the out-of-pocket costs to get screened or get diagnostic services.
